FY 2015 Budget Process: Coordination with Concord Finance Committee

Representatives of the School Committees and Administrative team met for a second time with the Concord Finance Committee on November 14 to present a proposed budget and to discuss budget priorities. The meeting is an opportunity to have a public dialogue and to share information about budget assumptions and cost drivers as well as how the school district will manage non-recurring expenses such as the potential purchase of Knox Trail land. This is an important step in crafting the budget that will be presented to citizens at Town Meeting. The Finance Committee is expected to vote on their final budget guidelines for the school districts on Thursday, November 21.
