As the Committees were welcoming the new members, Fatima Mezdad commented, ""I am honored and humbled to have been elected to the Concord School Committee. I see this as an opportunity for my own personal growth as I look forward to learning from each of my colleagues on the committee as well the excellent talent and expertise in our school district and in our community of students and families. I will support and coax our district towards the ambitious goals set in our strategic plan by broadening the spectrum and the lens through which we view our past, present and future. I am a Muslim immigrant and single parent on the lower end of the socio-economic scale raising a family in an affluent town. Alexa Anderson added, "I've lived nearly my entire life in Concord and I'm so grateful to be able to raise my children here. After serving on the District's strategic planning committee, I wanted to be a part of seeing the goals set by that committee achieved and the School Committee was the best vehicle to accomplish that task."

One of the first orders of business for the new Committees was to elect Chairs. Members of the Committee voted for Court Booth to serve as Chair for the Concord School Committee and Sara Wilson was elected Chair for the Concord-Carlisle Regional School Committee.

The Committees immediately started a goal setting process that is expected to be completed by the end of October.
