## **CLOSE CONTACT GUIDELINES**

A Close Contact is defined as anyone who has been <u>less than</u> 3 feet of the infected person for at least 15 minutes (cumulative).

## **EXPOSURE TO POSITIVE CASE**

\*Day "0" is the last day of contact - Quarantine begins on Day "1"\*



Complete a <u>7-DAY QUARANTINE</u> and obtain a PCR/rapid molecular test 3-4 days <u>after</u> last exposure to close contact. REMEMBER:
Staff/students may <u>NOT</u>
return to school
while awaiting
COVID-19 test results.



May return on day 8, after completing <u>7-DAY</u> <u>QUARANTINE</u> *IF you*:

- provide evidence of negative PCR test to school nurse AND
- remain symptom-free AND
- continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days.

If symptomatic, refer to "Symptom Guidelines" flowchart.

\*People who are fully vaccinated (post-14 days) OR who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 months and have recovered do NOT have to quarantine or get tested unless they develop symptoms again.\*

Contact tracing occurs at the individual student level and depends on a variety of factors based on the **DESE Guidelines**.
