The Concord Middle School Building Committee Report: Committee advances warrant article language and continues value management due diligence; upcoming meetings

Consistent with the vote taken by the Concord Select Board in November for a total project budget not to exceed \$104 million, the Concord Middle School Building Committee voted to submit a project budget of \$103,700,000 for the language in the debt exclusion warrant article at its meeting held on November 12th. There was consensus on The Committee that this action met both the spirit and letter of the Select Board vote as nearly \$1 million was identified in savings via value management. The budget level includes a bidding contingency line item that acknowledges the uncertainty of the pandemic's impact on potential cost increases that may occur between the Special Town Meeting and when the project team receives construction bids. Additional savings could also be realized as the bidding contingency approved in the vote is in addition to the existing contingency budget that routinely is planned for such projects. If bidding comes in as predicted in the current estimates which include cost escalators, the bidding contingency portion of the budget will not be spent.

While The Committee voted the \$103,700,000 total project budget, that amount represents a ceiling for costs as they were required to finalize language for the warrant in November to meet the statutory schedule for the Special Town Meeting. That vote did not preclude the Committee from continuing its due diligence regarding value management at its meetings in November and December. During those meetings, The Committee identified \$912,147 in value management project changes which resulted in a proposed new total project budget of \$102,716,610. Since the project estimates were returned in late October, The Committee has reduced the proposed total project budget by a total of \$1,740,145 through its value management efforts. Members of the Committee have worked hard to ensure that these cost saving efforts do not have an adverse impact on the educational program for the proposed building while bringing the total project budget in line with the Select Board vote and consistent with what was presented at Town Meeting when residents approved funding for the Feasibility and Schematic Design Phases.
